- Originally dedicated as “The Pines” in 1917.
- Initial 200 acres of land was purchased by the MI legislature to preserve the virgin pine stand for \$60,000.

North of present State Park Entrance.

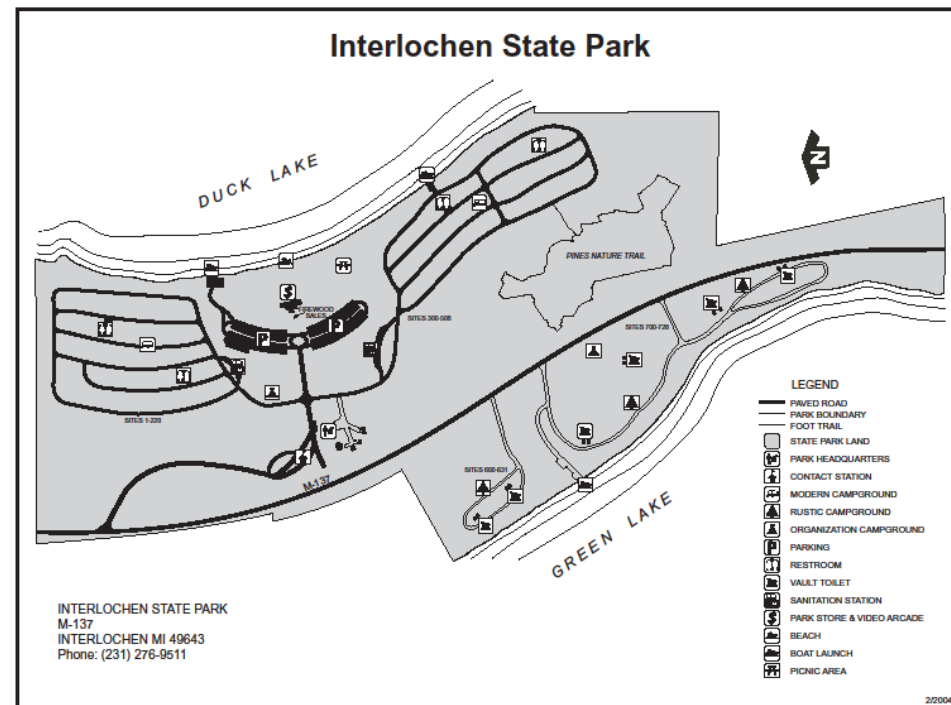

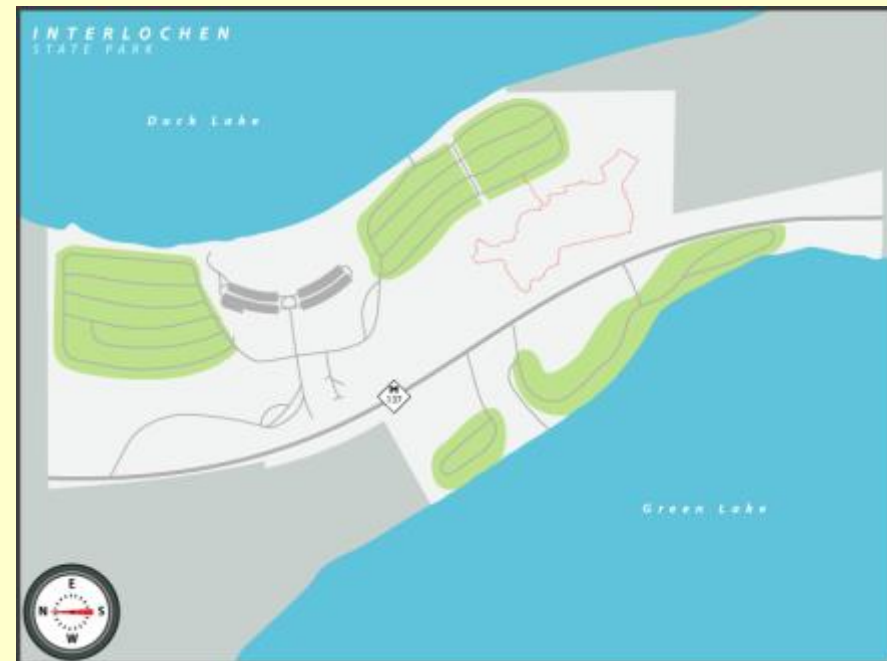

Fishing

- Duck Lake fishermen will find a variety of fish including bullhead, smallmouth bass, whitefish, largemouth bass, lake trout, brown trout, pumpkinseed sunfish, northern pike, yellow perch and bluegill.
- Green Lake fishermen will find a variety of fish including bluegill, largemouth bass, lake trout, brown trout, northern pike, sucker, pumpkinseed sunfish, smelt, smallmouth bass, bullhead, rock bass and yellow perch.
- Other lakes and streams in the area offer tremendous fishing opportunities as well.
