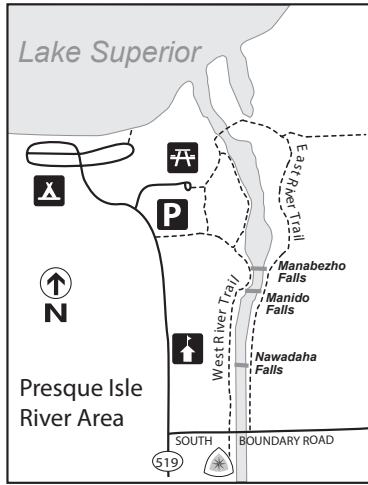
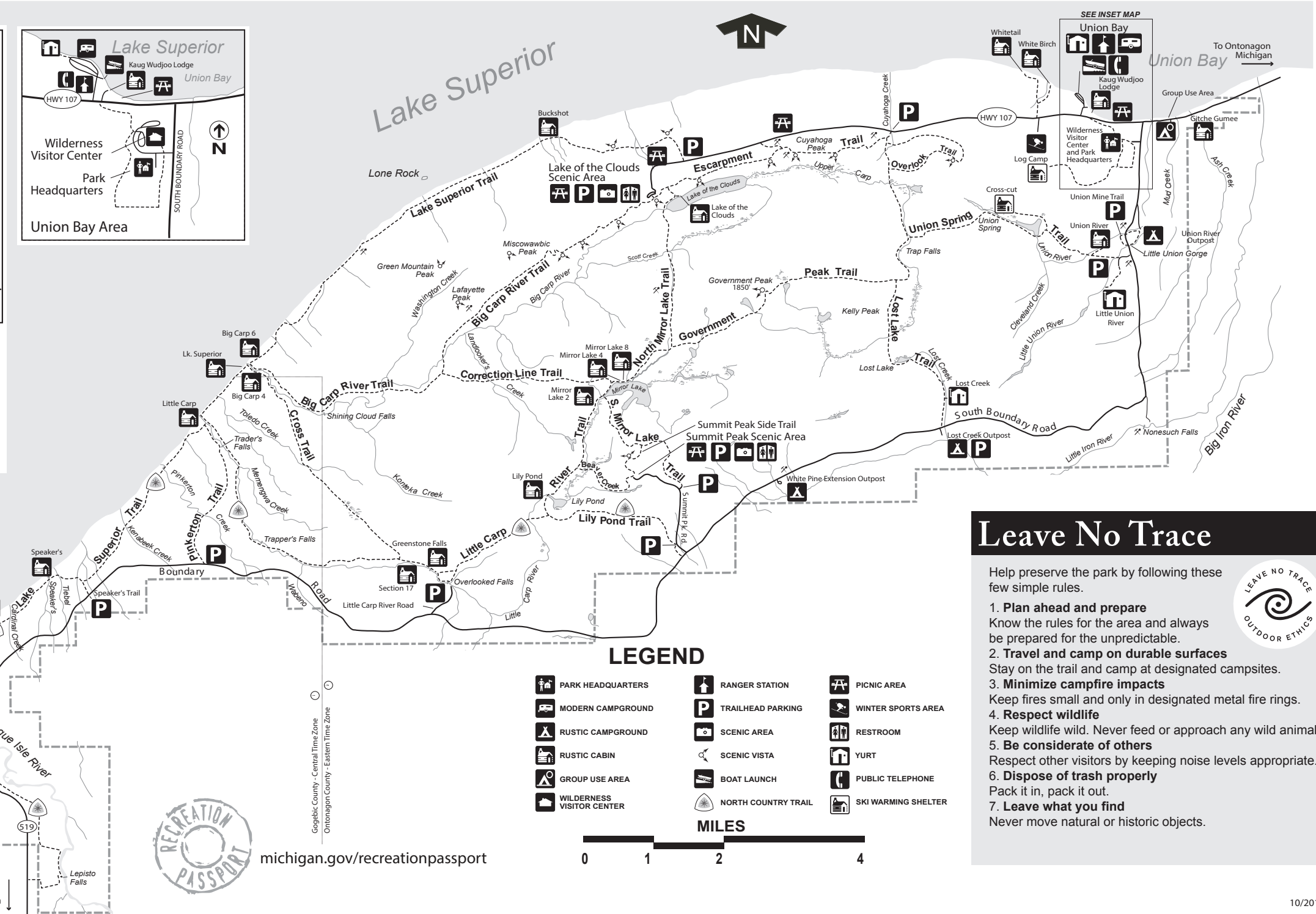
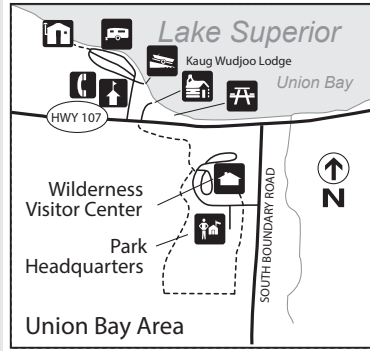


Porcupine Mountains Wilderness State Park

Leave No Trace

Help preserve the park by following these few simple rules.

- 1. Plan ahead and prepare**
Know the rules for the area and always be prepared for the unpredictable.
- 2. Travel and camp on durable surfaces**
Stay on the trail and camp at designated campsites.
- 3. Minimize campfire impacts**
Keep fires small and only in designated metal fire rings.
- 4. Respect wildlife**
Keep wildlife wild. Never feed or approach any wild animal.
- 5. Be considerate of others**
Respect other visitors by keeping noise levels appropriate.
- 6. Dispose of trash properly**
Pack it in, pack it out.
- 7. Leave what you find**
Never move natural or historic objects.
